Genetic Disorder Infographic Instructions

Use the “NEED TO KNOW” box as a starting point on pages 442-443 in your textbook.

- Your infographic **MUST** include the following:
 1. Name of disorder
 2. Statistics of affected people
 3. Genotype information
 4. Phenotype information/symptoms
 5. Genetic Incidence
 6. Photo of a patient with genetic disorder (should be exhibiting symptoms if possible)
 7. Current treatment options
- Your infographic may also include:
 - Name of gene involved
 - Actual DNA sequences affected
 - Sample pedigree with affected individuals
